If you had asked Nissim just a few months ago whether his daughter might end up in a Jewish school, he wouldn'thave laughed, but he would have told you it was impossible. Not unlikely. Not difficult. Impossible.

He would've listed the reasons, calmly.

First, she wouldn't go. She had no interest in religion. She'd grown up in America, gone through the public school system, and made it clear that she wanted to live as a regular American kid. Second, even if she did want to go, he couldn't afford it. And third, maybe most honestly, he wasn't ready for her to be "more religious" than him.

He believed there was a Creator. He was traditional. Respectful. But not religious.

His daughter, however, was different story altogether.

Born in America, raised on pop culture and public school, her connection to Yiddishkeit was less than zero. She didn't just not care; she wanted no part of it. Judaism was a relic, something from her father's past that she had no interest in carrying forward.

And Nissim, despite the ache in his heart, understood.

Then something happened. A classmate told her he was thinking of switching to the Jewish Academy and invited her to come too.

The parents, frustrated by her complete rejection to Judaism, took it as an opportunity and asked her to give it a try and take a tour of the school. She agreed. She bumped into one of the teachers during the

tour and they had a long meaningful conversation. She told her parents right then: "I am going to this school tomorrow! I want to be part of this Jewish school."

Nissim couldn't believe it. He hadn't expected her to say yes to the tour, let alone decide to enroll. But the challenge wasn't over. Tuition was still an issue.

Through Oorah's Tuition Program, the family received financial assistance. And as part of the program, Nissim was paired with a TorahMate.

Nissim wasn't sure what to expect. He was 45, born in Morocco and raised in Israel. His lifestyle was traditional but not religious. His TorahMate, Rabbi Yosef Aryeh Felsen, was a 63-year-old Chassid from Williamsburg. Not a kiruv professional. Not someone trained to bridge these kinds of gaps. Just a Yid who loved Torah and felt lucky to be who he was.

At first, Nissim worried they wouldn't connect. But by the second session, that fear was gone.

While his daughter was diving headfirst into her new Jewish world, his TorahMate gave him a way to come along for the ride. Instead of watching from the sidelines, he was learning too by asking questions, gaining clarity, even taking on small steps of his own. It meant that when his daughter grew, he didn't feel left behind. They were on the journey together.

And with his daughter now immersed in a Jewish environment, things at home started to shift too. When she began keeping Shabbos,

he tried to keep it with her. When she said she only eats kosher now, he started buying kosher too. One Friday morning, he asked why she wasn't going to school, not realizing it was Asarah B'Teves. When she told him she was fasting, he fasted too.

A short while ago, he went to speak with the principal. Before the meeting, the principal said, "Come with me, I want to show you something."

She opened a classroom door.

There stood his daughter, alone, her siddur open. Davening. Not posed. Not aware that anyone was watching. Just a girl, once allergic to anything Jewish, pouring her heart out to Hashem.

He didn't say anything.

He couldn't.

The same girl who once mocked it all now looked like she had been born for it. Like she was coming home.

And maybe, just maybe, he was too.

Meet and Greet

Oorah staff meet with parents over a Zoom interview to get to know them, understand their interest in growing in Judaism, and introduce them to all that Oorah has to offer.



Background Check

Our Yichus Department carefully reviews family records and other relevant information pertaining to each child's halachic Jewish status.



Yeshiva Placement

Our yeshiva placement staff work together with the parents and the school to help the child get accepted and ensure it's the right fit.



Acceptance to Tuition Program

Mazel tov — accepted! This is likely one of the most life-altering and positive decisions the family will make! Oorah will be by their side every step of the way, helping financially and partnering with them to ensure their child's success in their Jewish education.



Parents Get TorahMate Parents take on TorahMates (if they don't already have one), helping them understand what their child is learning and giving them a mentor to discuss, ask, and grow with — benefiting both their child and their own growth.



Junior TorahMates Oorah offers a Junior TorahMate to help fill in the gaps in a child's Jewish learning.



Packages Oorah sends care packages to help children bring their yeshiva learning home by providing them with practical tools and inspiration. Families receive "Welcome to School" packages with backpacks and school supplies, as well as Yom Tov packages with items like matzah, lulav and esrog, and a menorah to help them celebrate properly.

From **Public School** to BMG

I didn't grow up frum. Honestly, I didn't even know what that word meant. I went to public school until ninth grade, and when it came time for high school, my parents and I didn't know where to turn. Our rabbi suggested a Jewish school, and it looked amazing. warm, and welcoming. But then we saw the tuition bill.

We wanted a Jewish education, but we simply couldn't afford it. Then someone said, "There's an organization that helps families like yours." And that's how we found

Oorah decided to help a public school kid who wanted to grow. Because of them, I was able to attend that Jewish school and meet rabbeim and frum friends who opened my eyes to a world I never even knew existed. That was the beginning of everything.

When I turned 18. I thought I'd do what most kids do — go to college. But my rebbi looked at me and said, "Now's the time to learn." I told him I couldn't afford Yeshiva, and he said, "Don't worry — Oorah will help." And they did.

I went to Aish-Gesher in Yerushalayim. I didn't even know how to learn Gemara then. I couldn't read Rashi — the letters looked like squiggles to me. But slowly, I started learning. I went to DU and ChillZone, where I discovered that learning Torah could be joyful, that frumkeit could be real, warm, and geshmak. Those programs didn't just teach me — they changed me.

Later, I went to a yeshiva college, instead of going to a state university as I was originally planning. I continued growing, and then back to Eretz Yisroel to learn in a prestigious "Brisk" level Yeshiva, once again with Oorah by my side. They helped with tuition, with pocket money, with everything. Those years in Eretz Yisroel reshaped who I am and who I want to be.

Baruch Hashem, today I'm married and learning fulltime in BMG. My parents now have TorahMates. My sisters are going to seminary. Our entire family made a complete 180, from public school to Torah.

All because of Oorah.

Oorah doesn't just help people. They believe in people. They invest in neshamos — in families, in futures.



In shuls, people bid for aliyos with money.

In yeshivos, they bid for a blatt Gemara.

But in TheZone, the currency looks a little different.

Here, the excitement fills the room long before anything starts. Boys crowd around, each one eager for a chance to take part in saying a pasuk in Atah Hor'eisa.

But these bids aren't in dollars. They're in kabbalos.

I'll say a bracha on one food every day.

I'll wear my tzitzit to school.

I'll try to keep Shabbos for 4 weeks.

Each kabbalah is a diamond, each pasuk in Atah Hor'eisa a crown earned with sincerity and fire. And the singing and dancing that follow are Simchas Torah in its truest form.

As the singing swells and the circles of dancing grow wider, you can see it on their faces — the pride, the joy, the belonging.

The joy of being a Yid who wants more. Ashreinu - mah tov chelkeinu...





From the other side of the Mechitza

The bidding started off as a currency to "buy" a Pasuk in Ata Hor'eisa. However, the momentum shifted as the inspiration spread and intensified. People felt the spirit of Simchas Torah is to connect to Hashem and His Torah by accepting a commitment in Torah. The women began to make Kabbalos even though they did not receive a Pasuk.

Kabbalos from women included:

I will...

- ...bake challah so I can say the bracha.
- ...say brachos on food with more kavana.
- ...be sure to have more patience for my children.
- ...learn the Halachos of Shmiras Halashon.
- ...light Shabbos candles a few minutes early to welcome Shabbos calmly.


